



Phyllis Jennette Styron

March 30, 1927 - September 12, 2017

Phyllis Zoellner Styron, long time resident of Hobart Oklahoma died at her home in Hobart on Tuesday, September 12th, 2017. Phyllis was 90 years old at the time of her death. She was born in Mountain View Oklahoma on March 30th, 1927 to Edward and Blanche Zoellner. Phyllis graduated from Classen High School in Oklahoma City, attended Lindenwood College St. Charles Missouri and the University of Oklahoma. She married James C. Styron Jr. on September 1st, 1949. The newlywed couple established their home in Hobart where they raised their five children and operated Styron Wholesale Company. Phyllis was an active member in her community serving as the Secretary of the Kiowa County Election Board, the executive director of the Hobart Salvation Army and a member of the First Christian Church Hobart. She was involved in local, state and national politics throughout her life. Phyllis was a member of the women's delegation who traveled to Washington DC to oppose and eventually stop the Department of Defense initiative to dramatically expand the land area of Fort Sill that would have resulted in the confiscation of vast tracks of private property in Southwest Oklahoma. She was preceded in death by her husband James C. Styron Jr., her parents Edward and Blanche Zoellner of Mountain View, her siblings Georgia Mae Gish, John Zoellner, and Roy Zoellner. Phyllis is survived by her sister Betty Mullican of Phoenix Arizona. Phyllis is also survived by her five children, her daughter Ann Weder and son-in-law Don of Highland Illinois, and four sons, Lieutenant Colonel Retired James C.

Styron III and daughter in-law Judi of Springfield Virginia, Lieutenant Colonel Retired Howard T. Styron and daughter in-law Mary of Lawton Oklahoma, Dr. Stephen L. Styron and daughter in-law Tina of Waverly Iowa and Joel S. Styron and daughter in-law Bridget of Cooperton Oklahoma; plus 19 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services for Phyllis are scheduled for Saturday September 16, 2017 at 11.00 A.M. at the People's Funeral Home Chapel 1400 W. Main, Lone Wolf, Oklahoma with interment at Rose Cemetery in Hobart.
