



## Raymond Dale Reimer

April 30, 1934 - October 16, 2023

Raymond Dale Reimer passed away at the age of 89 on October 16, 2023. He was born April 30, 1934 at Cordell, OK to Clarence and Frances (Hines) Reimer. He grew up in the Corn/Cordell area and attended school at Cordell. He was saved at the First Baptist Church in Cordell at an early age. Raymond joined the Navy on July 27, 1951 when he was seventeen. He was on a LST 859 Ship which took the Seamen to Korea. He was GMSN (Gunners Mate Seaman Navy). He was honorably discharged on July 26, 1955 and in the Reserves until 1959. He married Martha Trammel on May 25, 1956. They had two sons, Doug and Doyle. Raymond farmed in the Sentinel area. Raymond married Wilma Gaye Newberry Smith on June 29, 1991 at Elk City, OK. They moved to Crooked Creek Farm in 1993 where they raised wheat and cattle. In 2011 they moved to Elk City. In 2016 they returned to the farm south of Retrop. Raymond knew the history of tractors, he liked western movies, he could play his guitar and sing. He enjoyed listening to the country and western music of Johnny Cash, Don Williams, and others. He was a member of the First Baptist Church, Sentinel. He loved Jesus and visited with Him often. The Bible was important to him. Revelation was his favorite book. He wanted to see where his Dad is buried at Herold Mennonite Church near Corn. On October 7, 2023 which was a good day for Raymond, we made the trip. He enjoyed every part of the trip including the place he would go swimming on a summer day with his Uncle Marvin. On October 10, 2023 he wanted to start the John Deere tractor one more time. We made it happen to his satisfaction.

Raymond is survived by wife Wilma Gaye, son Doug and wife Sandy, their two daughters Ashton Iven, husband Chad, great granddaughter Journey Lane and daughter

Delaney. Son Doyle, his son Jesse and wife Sydney, and Doyle's daughter Emily.

Step granddaughter Angela Pooch and step grandsons Woody Smith and Casey Smith. They loved Raymond dearly. We will all miss him so very much. He was preceded in death by his father Clarence and mother Frances.
