July 6, 1917 - September 24, 2012

Rebecca Sue Futrell Evans was born on July 6, 1917 and passed away on September 24, 2012. She was the daughter of Benjamin F. Futrell and Lillie May Cheshier Futrell. Rebecca grew up in the Malesus community of Jackson and graduated from Malesus High School in 1935 where she was class Valedictorian. After graduation she attended Lambuth College and was associated with the sorority that later became Alpha Omicron Pi.

On September 25, 1937, she married James Melvin Evans and they made their home in Jackson for more than fifty years. They had three sons, Jerry Don Evans, Joe David Evans, and James Barry Evans. Mrs. Evans worked as an elementary school teacher for the Madison County School District and later worked for the Tennessee Department of Human Services in the Child Welfare Division. She was a member of the Malesus Baptist Church and taught an adult Sunday School Class for many years. In 2005 due to failing health, Mrs. Evans moved to Altus, OK to be close to family and daughter-in-law, Nancy Oakley Evans.

Mrs. Evans was preceded in death by her parents, her brother, Jimmy, and all of her children; Jerry, Joe and Jimmy.
