Robert "Bob" Wayne Clark passed and arosed peacefully to be with his Saviour on Easter Sunday, April 5, 2026. He was 88 years old. Born on April 1, 1938, during a snowstorm in Shattuck, Oklahoma, Bob lived a life full of faith and adventure including hunting, snow& water skiing, and scuba diving. His scuba diving took him around the Caribbean where he swam with whale sharks, sting rays, and sea turtles. But as much as he loved adventure, he loved spending time with his family and friends even more. He thoroughly enjoyed family and friend get togethers with all the "fixins" heaped generously on his plate. Bob also had a great sense of humor and loved a good laugh. He graduated from Southwestern Oklahoma State University with a B.A. and master's degrees in education. Bob had numerous jobs and occupations including farmer, rancher, rough necker, teacher, and counselor. Bobs first job away from the farm was as an oil rough necker in West Texas. Bob taught History and coached football and track for 11 years in Temple, Laverne, and Fairview. In 1974, Bob moved his family to Altus, Oklahoma where he became a Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor until his retirement in 1991 and then became a full-time rancher. Bob was a devoted husband and father. He married his high school sweetheart, Jane Meacham in Ft Stockton, Texas on July 20, 1957. Together they enjoyed sharing a 68- year marriage grounded in faith, trust, respect and love. He is survived by his loving wife Jane, son Kirk and his wife Antonette, grandson Grant, and his sister Sheila. He was predeceased by his parents Vernon Jackson Clark and Catherine Kosanke,
