Ruby Jewel Beasterfeld, age 92, formerly of Lone Wolf, went to her heavenly home on November 11, 2016. The eldest of seven children, she was born at home in the Lake Creek area on November 6, 1924 to Sammie Jay and Eunice Jewel Vickery. She got her one last wish and died peacefully at her home, The Cordell Christian Home in Cordell.

Ruby married Chris Beasterfeld and celebrated their 59th wedding anniversary prior to his passing in 2014.
