July 17, 1931 - September 20, 2023

Sarah Doris (Burcham) Schreiner was born July 17, 1931, to W.F. (Bill) and Maurine (Whitener) Burcham in Reed, Oklahoma. She was the oldest of 3 children. Sarah was welcomed into heaven on September 20, 2023, with her daughters by her side. Sarah was 92 years, 2 months, and 3 days old. She graduated from Lone Wolf High School in 1949. She attended Oklahoma College for Women in Chickasha, Ok, for two years. She married her high school sweetheart, Wayne Schreiner, on Sept 8, 1951, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Lone Wolf, Ok. At this time Wayne was in the Air Force and they moved to Waco, TX and then to Sacramento, CA. They returned to Lone Wolf in 1955 to farm. Sarah completed her education at Southwestern Oklahoma State University with a degree in Education. Later, Sarah would earn a master's degree in Reading (SWOSU). Teaching English at Lone Wolf High School was the beginning of her teaching career. She taught kindergarten when Garrison Kindergarten first opened, then finished her career in education teaching 1st grade in Hobart Ok. Sarah retired in 1994 after teaching for 40 plus years. After retirement she served on the school board at Lone Wolf for several years.

Sarah enjoyed cooking (she was famous for her brioche), sewing, reading, quilting, and especially spending time with her daughters, grandchildren, and great grandchildren.

Sarah is survived by her daughters Nola and Bob Pirog of Yukon, OK and Nancy and Roger Moyer of Elk City, OK. She leaves a legacy of
