Shaun passed away on Sunday, January 7, 2018 in Lawton, Oklahoma.

Shaun moved around when he was young due to Red's military career, but the family finally settled down in 1971 in Granite, Oklahoma, where Shaun excelled as a baseball player and spent many summers on his grandparents farm, hauling hay. Until his health declined Shaun was the Director at Jackson County EMS, ACLS/BLS instructor, and was also an emergency room RN in Altus, Oklahoma. He loved taking care of others and training new medics, but he loved his grandkids and family more than anything else. Some of Shaun's hobbies included: bird and deer hunting, fishing, camping, reading a good book, watching the history channel, but most he loved spending time with his children and grandchildren.
