



## Steve Leonard Graumann

October 12, 1956 - May 1, 2019

Steve Leonard Graumann was born on October 12, 1956, in Hobart, Oklahoma to Leonard E. Graumann and Albertina (Mueller) Graumann. He was baptized on November 4, 1956, and confirmed in his faith on March 22, 1970, at St John's Lutheran Church where he remained a lifelong member. Steve grew up and attended school in Granite. After graduation, he went to Weatherford and studied Industrial Arts but farming was his first love so he returned home to join his dad and brother in the LKS Farms' operation where he spent his entire life. The operation consisted primarily of cotton and wheat, but Steve especially enjoyed raising cattle.

During his youth, if there was some mischief to be found Steve was very possibly the master mind. This often times did not work out well for him. He never felt the need to be politically correct which, at times, did not work out so well either. His slow Southern drawl would mislead some to think they could deceive him. But Steve was not one to let much slip past him. He loved conversing with people and had a gift for remembering details of their lives and families. His attention for details poured over to OU football where he was considered a statistician among those who knew him. He was a current and proud season ticket holder for Sooner football for 47 years. He also enjoyed fishing and hunting and was happy to host Toby Keith on the farm property on several occasions. He will also be remembered for his unique and great sense of humor which could be quite entertaining.

Although Steve never married he thought Allison and Tyler were his own.

Wade and Griffin were the light of his life and he cherished every hug and visit with them.

Steve was called to his heavenly home on May 1, 2019, in Oklahoma City at age 62. He was preceded in death by his father Leonard Graumann, brother Keith Alan Graumann and nephew Patrick Hudson. He is survived by his mother Albertina Graumann of Southlake, Texas, two sisters; Aline Perry and husband Steve also of Southlake, Texas, Patsy Hudson of Granite, niece Allison Richey and husband Tyler and their children Wade and Griffin of Altus, nephew Tyler Graumann and wife Kylie of Mangum, great nephew Brayden Hudson of Oklahoma City, and a host of other relatives and friends.

Services for Steve are scheduled for Monday, May 6, 2019, 10:00 A.M., at St. John's Lutheran Church in Granite with Pastor B.J. Armstrong officiating.

Interment will follow in the Lutheran Cemetery, Granite.
