



## Steven Frederic Harrison

January 1, 1946 - December 1, 2024

Steven Frederic Harrison “Steve” passed from this life on December 1, 2024, in Hobart, Oklahoma at the age of 78. Steven was born on January 1, 1946, to Freddie and Ellen (Allred) Harrison in Hobart. He lived in various houses in Hobart until 1956, when he moved to California for his father’s work. While in California, Steven joined the Boy Scouts and in 4 years became an Eagle Scout. In 1960, he returned to Hobart. In 1964, Steven graduated from Hobart High School. In 1966, he attended Cameron College, as well as the University of Oklahoma. Steven was drafted into the Army in 1966. He was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal, Vietnamese Tet Defense Medal, Purple Heart, Bronze Star, Distinguished Service Cross, Marksmanship Medals for M14, .45cal, M60, 50cal machine gun, and 106 recoilless rifle. From 1968-1978 Steven lived in Perryton, Texas for 10 years after the Army, working in the oilfield. From 1978-1984, he lived in Cortez, Colorado for 6 years, Working as an office manager for the city natural gas system. In 1984, Steven returned to Hobart, after working at various locations for the oil field. He received a professional engineer certification and was a member of the county economic board.

Steven is survived by his son Robert Allen Harrison and wife Jennifer of Savannah, GA, daughter Ginger Lee Harrison-Moore and husband Patrick of Atlanta, GA, sister Linda Thornley of Alvin, TX, Kathy Harrison of Springfield MO, grandchildren Robert Allen Harrison Jr., Steven T. Harrison, Michael Harrison, Carlen Moore, Cullen Moore, and great grandchild John T Harrison.

Steven is preceded in death by his parents Freddie and Ellen, brother Michael Wayne Harrison, and sister Nancy Cole.
