



Tara Jane Bone

August 21, 1962 - June 18, 2022

On Saturday June 18th 2022 Tara Jane Healy Bone passed away, surrounded by family and friends. She is survived by her husband Frank Bone, son Frankie Bone and daughter Lillie Bone of Granite, brother Rick Healy of Oklahoma City, sister Toni Bain and her husband Tom of Oklahoma City, sister Robyn Campbell and her husband Dan of Oklahoma City, sister Monica Ball and her husband Jacques, and her step-mother Julie Healy of Norman, Oklahoma, along with a host of other relatives and friends.

Tara was born on August 21, 1962 to Robert and Anne Healy. She received a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice at Oklahoma State University. She dedicated her life to public service with occupations as a dispatcher, law enforcement officer, and social worker. Tara was the dispatch supervisor for the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office. She met the love of her life Frank Bone, and on July 2, 1997 they were married. After adopting children of their own, she decided to become a social worker for the Oklahoma Department of Human Services. She worked there until she and her husband moved the family to Granite, Oklahoma where she started work in the prison system as a case manager. She also served on the Granite Public School Board for 7 years, even after her own children had graduated. At the time of her passing, she was a parole investigator for the Pardon and Parole Board, a job that allowed her to work from home.

In 2017, she was diagnosed with a very aggressive form of breast cancer. From that moment, she faced her diagnosis with courage, strength, optimism, and hope. She made the choice to fight and that's what she did every step of the way, no matter what happened. She was a fighter, but when people would tell her that, she always said there was no other option, and she was just doing what she had to do. That's who Tara Jane was. All the time we were blessed to have her, and all throughout her hard-fought battle she continued to work, to be active in her community, to help anyone who needed it, to light up every room she walked in, to be a best friend to all, to laugh often, to love and care for her family, to love Jesus, and to live her life to the very fullest.

A Family Directed Memorial Service will be held Saturday, July 9, 2022, 10:30 A.M. at the Granite School Auditorium in Granite, Oklahoma with Pastor Tim Montgomery officiating.
