Vada Faye Everhart, 86, Lone Wolf OK, was born to Floyd and Edna (Wheeler) Newton in Lone Wolf, Oklahoma on April 11, 1935 and departed this life in Hobart, Oklahoma, on April 29, 2021. Vada lived her entire life in Lone Wolf and was a proud 1953 graduate of Lone Wolf High School.

On April 3, 1954, Vada married the love of her life, Herman Jacob Everhart and they were blessed with two children, Herman Clayton and Laura Lynne.

Vada was a member of the Lone Wolf Assembly of God Church for many years, serving as a Sunday School teacher and Church Secretary/Treasurer. Vada loved going to church. She loved Jesus with her whole heart which was evident in her daily life by her kind, sweet spirit.

Vada worked at the Kiowa County A.S.C.S. Office until the birth of her daughter in 1957. Vada devoted her life to Jesus and her family. She cared for her husband, "H.E." at home 40 years after his injury in a car accident left him quadriplegic. Together they sold 2-way radios for many years. After H.E.'s death, she continued to sell propane supplies all across the country until her illness January 1, 2021. She also farmed, drove a tractor, and raised cattle. She absolutely loved the farm life and her family. Her latest passion was her granddaughter, Callie Brooke, whom she adored more than anything.

Vada is preceded in death by her parents, sister, Artie Lemmon, brothers, Rev. Dane Newton, Rev. Grant Newton, and Rev. Curtis Newton.

Survivors include a son and daughter-in-law, Clayton Everhart and Valerie of Lone Wolf, a daughter and son-in-law, Laura Lynne and Joe Peterson of

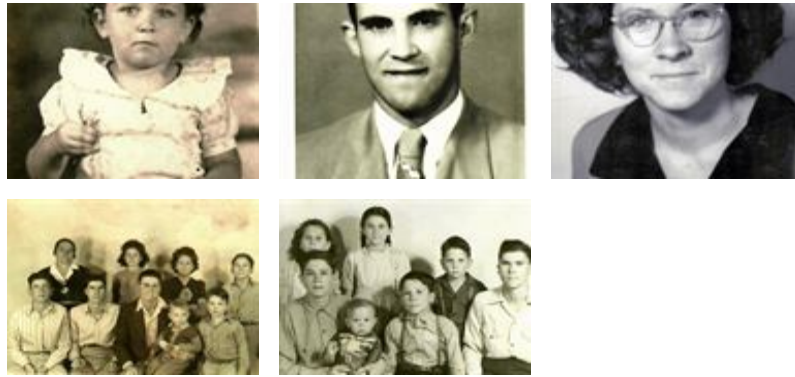
