Verma Williams Tapp was born to Edward Jesse and Myrtice (Moore) Williams on October 15, 1927 in Odum, Georgia and departed this life on December 11, 2013 in Mineral Wells, Texas at the age of 86 years, a month and 26 days.

Verma married Curtis W. Tapp September 6, 1947 in Douglas Georgia. Curtis and Verma Tapp in the early years of their marriage moved to different locations where Curtis taught school and Verma kept the home and took care of the children as they came along. smile and laugh, keeping us entertained and we remember her in bare feet working in kitchen humming or whistling a hymn. She lived a long productive life but even in trials and tribulations was always faithful trusting in the Lord. We will miss her very much but are comforted in the knowledge she is enjoying a great reunion with loved ones that have gone on before and being in the presence of the Lord Jesus.

She was preceded in death by her parents Ed and Myrtice Williams; husband Curtis W. Tapp; and a sister, Sara Lofty.
