Ross Baker, age 82, passed from this life on December 10, 2023, at his home surrounded by his family. He was born on April 26, 1941, in El Paso, Texas to Virgil Buford Baker and Willie Opal (Allison) Baker. Ross attended school and graduated from Austin. He worked for a little while and then continued his education at Austin College in Sherman, Texas. Ross joined the USAF in 1960 and retired as MSGT, Survival Specialist, after twenty years of service to our country. He worked for Southern Prairie Library System for 15 years as the bookmobile librarian covering 2 counties. He retired from the library system in 2006. He was an avid reader, loved non-fiction about southwestern Oklahoma and was a long-time member of the Red River Cowboy Church. Ross is survived by his wife LaVerne of the home, daughter Lisa Denton and husband Van of Blair, and sister Rana Jean Sanders of Georgetown, TX. He leaves a legacy of three grandchildren, Brynna Danae Tennant and husband Travis, Clayton Daniel Baker, and Caleb Dillon Baker, great grandchildren, Kathryn Darby Tennant and Miles Deacon Tennant, and a host of other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his parents Virgil and Opal
