She never missed a school function the girls were in, she traveled to every basketball and softball game and helped with every fundraiser the girls had for this or that. She was a member of OHCE Great Expectations in Blair. Sue is preceded in death by her parents, two grandsons William Tice Weber and Cade P Clement. She is survived by her husband Doug of 47 years, daughters Michelle and husband Chad Clement of Blair, Mandy Tice of Altus, her pride

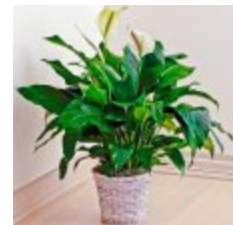
