Willie Edward Perry, 84 of Duke, Oklahoma, passed away on Thursday, November 20, 2025, at his home. Willie was born on May 12, 1941, in Valliant (Millerton) Oklahoma, to Willie Cranford Perry and Laura Lee (Harrington) Perry. Willie was born the middle child of 13. Born to sharecroppers, Willie grew up in southeastern OK, working in the fields and moving from farm to farm following the crops. The family migrated to southwestern OK when he was 16 and he remained in this area for the remainder of his life. Willie married Jaretha Worbes in 1962. To this union two daughters were born, Jareta Kay and Jaretta Gay. Willie married LaVern Brooks in 1982 and this marriage added two stepsons, Frank Osborne and Steve Osborne. Willie worked as a plumber for 42 years. After retiring from plumbing, Willie worked construction with his brother Harold. Actually, he never really retired as he worked hard all of his life and didn't know how to rest. He also loved fishing and having a fish fry for a house full of people. He loved working with his hands including building cabinets, furniture and shelling pecans. He also loved visitors, especially his little Quinn.
