Jean loved to go to garage sales, thrift store shopping, collect knick knacks, enjoyed her collection of plants that she would bring in each winter and care for them until spring and move them back out. She loved to attend the widow's tea every Wednesday at the West Side Baptist Church. Jean was of strong Baptist faith, always saw the good in everyone, never saying an unkind word about another person. She read her

bible daily and when she sent anyone a card, it always contained quotes from scripture. Her family was her pride and joy. She really enjoyed hosting birthday parties for her family and loved it when company came by to see her. She cared for and looked out for all of her siblings, nieces, nephews, greats and great greats. She will be greatly missed by her family and friends, leaving a void in their lives. Jean is survived by her daughter Pamela Lane and husband Gary Lane of Canton, Texas and son David Cain and wife Jennifer of Tulsa.
