Wilma Lee "Toots" (Cain) Woodard, a resident of Athens, Georgia passed away Tuesday, January 27, 2015, at High Shoals Health and Rehabilitation in Bishop, Georgia.

Wilma was born in Weatherford, Texas, on August 19, 1925, to Clarence and Angie (Denton) Cain. Wilma grew up in the Highway Community, Oklahoma, and graduated from the Highway School in the early 1940's. On July 6, 1943, Wilma married Lloyd C. "L.C." Woodard and they were married for over 55 years before L.C.'s death in August of 1998. As a young military couple, Wilma and L.C. lived in New Mexico and Macon, Georgia, where L.C. was stationed in the United States Army Air Corps. After L.C. was honorably discharged from the Air Corps, they returned to the Highway Community where they worked the Cain family farm until the late 1950's. With L.C.'s work, the family moved to East Texas then to West Texas and in 1959 to Atlanta, Georgia. Wilma and L.C. resided in Georgia for the rest of their lives. After L.C. retired, he and Wilma enjoyed traveling and selling Wilma's hand-made silver and gold jewelry. Wilma enjoyed oil painting and sewing, where in her earlier years, she made wedding gowns and competition dance costumes. In her later years she enjoyed leading groups of fellow retirees in craft groups. She really loved spending time with and taking care of her family and she always enjoyed being involved in all of Jack's sporting activities even through his years of coaching.

Preceded in death by her parents; her husband L.C.; and her infant daughter, Connie Lynn in 1946; Wilma is survived by her son, Jack of Monroe, Georgia; her sister, Juanita "Ikey" Ames of Colorado; two grandchildren, Kimberly Michele Solodkii and her husband Max and Britt Michael Woodard both of Georgia; two great grandchildren, Lex and Anslee Solodkii; a loving niece and nephew, other family members and friends.

Viewing will be held at 1:30 Saturday, January, 31, 2015, followed by the Funeral service at 3:00 pm, at Retrop Baptist Church in Carter, Oklahoma with Pastor Gary Vitosky officiating. Interment will follow at Poarch Cemetery near Carter, Oklahoma.
